The bread slicer HSA-55 with continuously rotating band blades, angled to pull the loaves smoothly through the blades, with the advantage that they are not pressed together, resulting in optimal slicing results.

Or the frame bread slicer HSB with the trusted principle of vertical moving knives which is ideal for products such as rye or fruit bread or different types of cake.

The Bagblower ensures that the bags are opened, so that products can be packed quickly and then closed on the intermittent conveyor with a clipband, tab lock, tape or twist tie closure.

Frame slicer HSB

► The method of slicing with a vertical moving knives makes it ideal for products such as rye or fruit bread or different types of cake.

Band slicer HSA-55

► Continuously rotating band blades, angled to pull the loaves through the blade to give the highest quality slice.





Closing conveyor HPL-KL

- ► Conveyor with Kwik Lok closing machine 910A
- ► Tab lock closure is made of plastic or paper
- ► Metal detector check possible
- ▶ Possible to print date or lot no

Closing conveyor HPL-20

- ► Conveyor with clipband closing machine
- ▶2 metal wires with plastic in between
- ▶ Possible to print date or lot no





tin baked bread and round bread. HSA-55 is not suitable for wet loaves or with ingredients like raisins or fruit



length: 200 - 360 mm width: 80 – 200 mm height: 70 – 160 mm



30-35 sliced loaves per minute, depending on the products, requirements and the operators working on the machine




standard is the slice thickness not adjustable, but each slice thickness from 9 mm is deliverable




suitable for different type and sizes of plastic bags on a wicket (paper bags on request)
